The Bob Hoffmann Memorial Scholarship is administered and funded by the statewide association of Wisconsin's automobile salvage industry known as Concerned Auto Recyclers of Wisconsin (C.A.R.S. of Wisconsin). C.A.R.S. was established in 1959 to promote the auto recycling industry and as a common ground for its members to exchange information and ideas to create progressive, safer, and more efficient work environments. These scholarships offered are to be a benefit to the many employees and their families to assist in continuing education. Bob Hoffman was a board member for many years. During his time he served as CARS President from 1990-1991 and 1991-1992. He was employed with Rhinelander Auto Salvage and LKQ-Smart Parts. He designed and implemented QRP and the QRP express system. One of his final projects was designing and helping with the implement of the CARS Warranty Program.

Eligibility:

1. Applicant can either be an employee, an owner, or have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is an employee or owner.
2. The employee/owner has to have been employed for at least one year at a business that is a "good standing" member of C.A.R.S.
3. Applicant must have a cumulative high school/college/technical school grade point average of 2.5 or higher.

Requirements:

1. Completed application form.
2. Letter of acceptance from the school you are or will be attending.
3. Verification of a 2.5 GPA or above.

Only those applicants that fully complete the entire application and submit all requested documents will be considered.
